- Professional **resume or CV**
- Completed **bachelor's degree** from accredited college or university
- Official transcripts:** Copies of official transcripts are acceptable for admissions purposes
 - Advising Report forms or web-based transcript information will not be accepted
 - Official transcripts sent from the school must be submitted by the end of the first semester to prevent registration holds
