Career Outcomes

Graduates of the online ASD graduate certificate program will be prepared to pursue many different careers serving students with ASD. For example, they may serve as special education teachers, or they may work as autism or behavior specialists at the local or state level. Outside of education, they may choose to utilize this knowledge working with Applied Behavior Analysis clinics, or they may pursue such roles as occupational therapists, speech language pathologists, music therapists or art therapists.

What You'll Learn

All certificate students will complete core coursework that gives them a full understanding of autism spectrum disorder as well as methods to work with and teach students with ASD. Students will learn to select, implement and evaluate evidence-based interventions and support strategies, empowering them to work more effectively with children and youth with ASD, including those with extensive cognitive or verbal support needs. Additionally, students will have an opportunity to demonstrate how to teach and promote social skills, social communication development and proactive social interactions, and they will develop expertise in specific assessment tools. Finally, students will explore and demonstrate their ability to connect assessment results to instruction and to report assessment results in a way that is both technically accurate and transparent to laypeople and other schoolbased professionals.
