Applicants to the online Master of Science in Education (M.S.E.) in Curriculum and Instruction are required to submit

the following materials and meet the following requirements before the designated application deadline:
Completed online application form
Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
<ul> <li>Applicants with an undergraduate GPA below 3.0 should contact a KU admissions advisor for more information</li> </ul>
Professional resume or CV
Completed bachelor's degree from accredited college or university
Official transcripts: Copies of official transcripts are acceptable for admissions purposes
<ul> <li>Advising Report forms or web-based transcript information will not be accepted</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Official transcripts sent from the school must be submitted by the end of the first semester to prevent registration holds</li> </ul>
