

Online Master's in High Incidence Disabilities

Applicants to the <u>online Master of Science in Education (M.S.E.) in special education with an emphasis in high</u> <u>incidence disabilities</u> are required to submit the following materials and meet the following requirements before the designated application deadline:

Completed online application form

Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)

- Applicants with an undergraduate GPA below 3.0 should contact a KU admissions outreach advisor for more information
- Professional resume or CV

Completed bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university

Official transcripts: Copies of official transcripts are acceptable for admissions purposes

- · Advising Report forms or web-based transcript information will not be accepted
- Official transcripts sent from the school must be submitted by the end of the first semester to prevent registration holds

Parchment or electronic transcripts received from the school are considered official and can be submitted to <u>gradadmin@ku.edu</u> or to the physical address below:

Letter of introduction stating your area of interest and licensure status

Two letters of recommendation from professional or academic references. Recommendations are collected via the online application system, and references will receive an email link with instructions to complete a letter of recommendation and survey

IELTS or TOEFL scores (for non-native English-speaking applicants)
