- ☐ Completed [online application form](#)
- ☐ Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
 - Applicants with an undergraduate GPA below 3.0 should contact a KU admissions outreach advisor for more information
- ☐ Professional resume or CV
- ☐ Completed bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
- ☐ Official transcripts: Copies of official transcripts are acceptable for admissions purposes
 - Advising Report forms or web-based transcript information will not be accepted
 - Official transcripts sent from the school must be submitted by the end of the first semester to prevent registration holds

- ☐ Two letters of recommendation from professional or academic references. Recommendations are collected via the online application system, and references will receive an email link with instructions to complete a letter of recommendation and survey

- ☐ IELTS or TOEFL scores (for non-native English-speaking applicants)
