Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)

Completed bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
Official transcripts: Copies of official transcripts are acceptable for admissions purposes
 Advising Report forms or web-based transcript information will not be accepted
 Official transcripts sent from the school must be submitted by the end of the first semester to prevent registration holds
